### **Knob Trim Ring (Decorative ring surrounding the valve stem) Removal and Replacement:**

#### **Removal:**

1. Ring plate is originally attached via double sided tape to the counter surface.
2. Using a flat edge blade (putty knife), slide the blade under the ring plate and the counter, and work around until the ring is loose and can be removed. (NOTE: Use care in protecting the surface if needed by temporarily covering the counter with painter's tape or other thin protective cover)

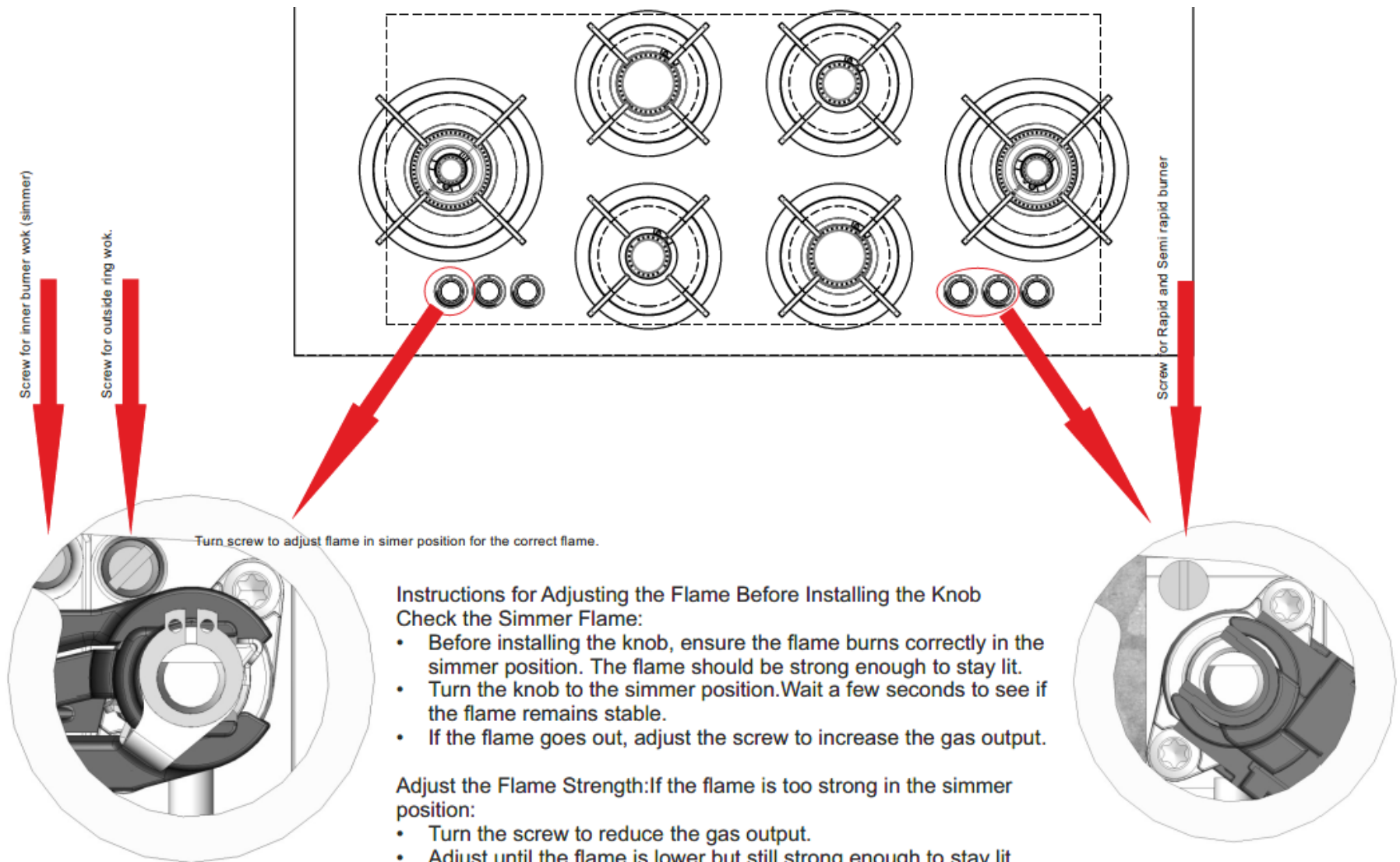
#### **Reinstallation:**

1. Clean the ring and remove any damaged tape.
2. Using new, clear double-sided tape, cut several pieces and apply them to the bottom of the ring, then remove the covering from the adhesive tape.
3. Positioning – Ensure the dot on the trim piece faces to the back of the cook top.
4. Lower the ring plate into position and press firmly.



### **Adjusting the Simmer Flame:**

1. Once the Knob Trim ring is removed, the simmer flame can be adjusted through the counter.
2. See the attached illustrations to identify the correct burner and adjustment screws.
3. With all burners lit, follow the instructions to adjust the flame in the simmer position.
4. Flame should be strong enough to remain lit after several minutes.
5. Once the flame is adjusted and the flame is consistent, you may want to place a pot of water on the burner to ensure the flame remains lit.



**Instructions for Adjusting the Flame Before Installing the Knob**  
**Check the Simmer Flame:**

- Before installing the knob, ensure the flame burns correctly in the simmer position. The flame should be strong enough to stay lit.
- Turn the knob to the simmer position. Wait a few seconds to see if the flame remains stable.
- If the flame goes out, adjust the screw to increase the gas output.

**Adjust the Flame Strength:** If the flame is too strong in the simmer position:

- Turn the screw to reduce the gas output.
- Adjust until the flame is lower but still strong enough to stay lit.
